



Uganda Mission Trip

Children to Love International

September or November, 2022



Partner with the Children to Love International ministry in Uganda to help with their 200+ orphaned, abandoned, and neglected children in a variety of ministry programs.

Your Assignment: Assist and support the *Mercy Childcare Ministry* (Children to Love's Ugandan partner) staff within a variety of ministry programs to help children and youth in need grow with God through games, songs, and scripture. Ministry programs involve working with children at the Mercy Village, helping with medical outreaches at the Mercy Medical Center for the people in the nearby community, and helping with activities at the Mercy Boarding School. The team will also be visiting women that are part of the Mercy Microloan Program that live in some of the poorest slums and share personal testimonies with them.

Specific Examples: The team will begin each day with a devotional and prayer. Each day the team will be working in one of the ministry programs sites (Village, Medical Center, School), with one group of kids in the morning and another group of kids in the afternoon. Typical activities with the children will be singing Christian songs, performing in a variety of skits with a biblical message, doing craft activities, engaging in team building games and sport activities and sharing personal testimonies.

Trip Cost: \$3,700 per participant and it is all-inclusive (estimated, based on current airfare). Costs include but not limited to round trip airfare, background check fee, travel health insurance, pre-trip training materials and sessions, housing, meals, in-country transportation, ministry/program expenses in Uganda, team fun day, and administration costs.

Qualification Requirements: Team members should have a willing heart to serve, be flexible before and during the mission trip, and participate in team meeting preparations and training prior to departure.

Physical Requirements: Team participants will be doing some walking during the trip, including walking to/from ministry site locations. Walking will include stairs and uneven pavement.

Housing Info: The team will be staying at Mercy Village in some of their guest houses.

Training: Prior to departure, the team members will participate in approximately 10-12 hours of training. Training will take place on a weekend with a CTL representative.

Other Logistics: A valid passport is required and must have at least 6 months beyond the departure date from Uganda. An entry tourist visa is required for short-term visits. Yellow Fever vaccine is required for entry. COVID-19 vaccine may be required by the country.
