Outline of Ecclesiastes 9:11-10:20

- Life is Unpredictable (9:11-12)
 - Wisdom is Unappreciated (9:13-16)
 - Wisdom is Valuable, yet may be Neutralized (9:17-10:20)
 - ➔ Wisdom’s value may be neutralized by a little sin or folly (9:17-10:3)
 - ➔ Wisdom’s value may be neutralized by an inept ruler (10:4-7)
 - ➔ Wisdom’s value may be neutralized by accidents (10:8-9)
 - ➔ Wisdom’s value may be neutralized by negligence or poor timing (10:10-11)
 - ➔ Wisdom’s value may be neutralized by foolish speech or conduct (10:12-15)
 - ➔ Wisdom’s value may be neutralized by immaturity (10:16-20)

Central Idea of Ecclesiastes 9:11-10:20

Embrace and value wisdom, even though it can be neutralized; because despite its limits, wisdom is essential to counter the folly and unpredictability of life.

 - Will you endeavor to gain wisdom by reading one chapter of Proverbs every day for the next month?
